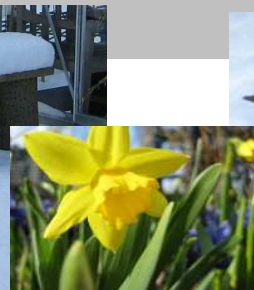

Committee Meeting 21st Feb - what was discussed?

- ⇒ **2009 Seeds** are in the shop, so please see Wally and pick up your seed orders
- ⇒ **Plot holder Agreements.** Majority of plot holders have sent back signed agreements. If you have not sent back the agreement, it will be considered as notice of plot termination, and you will receive an immediate termination letter. All those who sign and return the agreement will receive an invoice as usual in March. There is a slight rent increase.
- ⇒ **Plot inspections** were done in January. Termination procedure will be started for those not working their plots as described in the new agreements.
- ⇒ **Wind turbine.** Planning permission in progress, decision will be confirmed in May. After that Alan will apply for lottery funding, and hopefully the wind turbine will be installed by Autumn.
- ⇒ **Waiting list** of 50 is now closed, until the backlog decreases. In order to try to reduce the wait, newcomers will be offered a small 2-3 rod starter plot initially, to see how they like allotment gardening and would be offered a larger plot as soon as one becomes available. This has approached Greenwich council about the possibility of using some nearby vacant land for more KPAA allotment plots.
- ⇒ **Thomas Tallis school redevelopment** Planning approved and building work has started.
